Minimizing Exposure to Lead Paint

Did you know the rules for working around lead-based paint changed in 2010? We're working hard to educate our employees, clients, friends and neighbors about the current methods for minimizing exposure. Members of our team have completed Certified Lead Paint Specialist training and we are using safe practices on job sites now.
